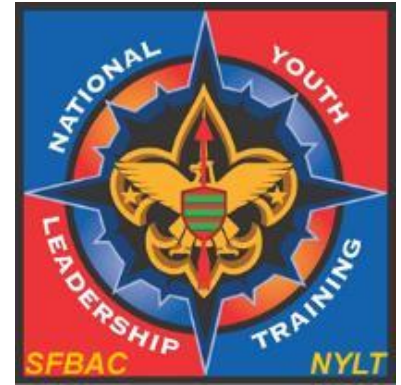

Taking NYLT Home

Your “homework” assignment



During your week at **SFBAC-NYLT**, you were taught many leadership and team-building skills. You can – and should – use each and every one of these skills when you return to your home unit. If you do, you and others will have a better Scouting experience. If you don’t use the skills you have learned, they won’t benefit you in scouting or in life in general.

You have completed your training in NYLT, but your training is not yet done!! **You have yet to “Take NYLT Home” with you.** You need to complete your training in order to be recognized at our Reunion and Recognition Meeting in November. Completion of the “Taking NYLT Home” assignment entitles you to wear the NYLT “Trained” strip on your uniform and is a pre-requisite if you want to apply for NYLT Staff next year.

Here is what you need to do:

1. Develop a **VISION** for your troop and discuss that **VISION** with your home unit leader.
2. Based on this **VISION**, and using the leadership skills learned at NYLT, develop a plan consisting of (3) three **SMART (SMART = Specific, Measurable, Attainable, Relevant, Timely) GOALS**. Assure that you and your unit leader agree on these goals before you implement the goals.
3. Implement your plan and complete these **SMART GOALS**. Upon completion of these **GOALS**, have your leader certify (on the next page) your achievement.

You and your home unit leader can visit our website www.sfbac-nylt.org for some sample **GOALS** that others have developed in the past.

Complete your **GOALS** before the third Thursday in November, so that you can be recognized at our Reunion and Recognition Meeting. Check our website for the location and date of this ceremony. You must confirm with your home unit leader that he/she has notified the SFBAC-NYLT Council Coordinator at info@sfbac-nylt.org that you have completed your **GOALS**.

If you don’t get your **GOALS** completed by the November meeting, not to worry. You can still complete your **GOALS** after November, just have your leader send an email to the SFBAC-NYLT Council Coordinator and we will mail your NYLT recognition package to you.
