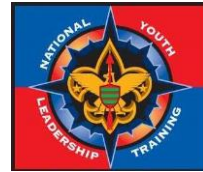

Why be a member of SFBAC-NYLT Staff?

SFBAC-NYLT Staff is hard work. We have roughly one evening meeting per month and a weekend commitment each month from January to June. However, if you look at a number of Council Level Scout functions, you will find NYLT Staff members there.

NYLT Staff is the leadership continuum beyond SFBAC – NYLT. You will get to know the leadership skills far better than you did during your course. You will learn by teaching the skills and learn by using the tools in a high-energy training course run by Scouts/Venturers. You will have to apply the NYLT Leadership Skills by acting as a Troop Guide (or other leadership position) to Scouts/Venturers who are being taught the skills. Through the materials you present and the example you set, you will be providing guidance and leadership to other Scouts/Venturers.

SFBAC-NYLT Staff is a lot of fun. You can tell that by looking at the tenure of many of our staff. If it weren't fun, they wouldn't come back. The weekend staff events do require that you prepare material and are ready to learn. But you learn new songs and skits as part of Staff Development and Mr. Merl makes sure that you are well fed.

You do things that other Scouts only dream about. The staff cut all of the staves each year so NYLT Staff gets the opportunity to fell down eucalyptus as part of a conservation program we do for the East Bay Regional Park System. Other special events are in the works this year to make NYLT even better for staff than it has ever been.

SFBAC Staff Application Steps –

1. **Check to make sure you can make all meetings and training weekends (see the calendar on the staff page (www.sfbac-nylt.org/Staff-NYLT.htm)).**
2. **Check with your unit leader to make sure that he/she approves of your application for staff.**
3. **Fill out the on-line application, confirming that you are available on the course and the training dates.**
4. **Wait to be contacted by e-mail after Thanksgiving on when you are to show up for your Staff interview, **either December 12 or December 17.****
5. **Prepare a 5-10 minute presentation with flip charts or PowerPoint slides for Interview**
6. **Be on time and in full uniform, have a song ready that you can lead.**
